#### ORDINANCE NO. 19-02-05-01

# AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND INCORPORATING THE WILL COUNTY STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE BY REFERENCE

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington ("City") is a member of the National Flood Insurance Program which makes property owners within the City eligible to obtain flood insurance;

WHERAS, on December 16, 2003, the City passed a Resolution 2003-19 adopting the then-current Will County Storm Water Management Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") has updated its Flood Insurance Study and Flood Insurance Rate Maps to identify areas of special flood hazard area ("SFHA"), which, due to the likelihood of flooding, are subject to higher regulatory requirements and insurance rates than properties not located in a SFHA;

WHEREAS, prior to February 15, 2019, the City is required to adopt the amended Flood Insurance Study and Flood Insurance Rate Maps for those areas within the corporate limits of the City or within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City that may be annexed into the City to remain in the National Flood Insurance Program;

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2018, Will County amended its Stormwater Management Ordinance to incorporate FEMA's updated Flood Insurance Study and Flood Insurance Rate Maps;

WHEREAS, the City believes that the Will County Stormwater Management Ordinance meets all requirements of 44 CFR 60.3(d) except for the explicit adoption of the Flood Insurance Studies and Flood Insurance Rate Maps relevant to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS STATUTORY AND OTHER POWERS AS FOLLOWS AS FOLLOWS:

# SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF SECTIONS 159.14 AND 159.15 TO THE WILMINGTON CODE OF ORDINANCES

The Wilmington Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to include Section 159.14 – Will County Stormwater Management Ordinance Adopted and Section 159.15, as set forth below:

#### Section 159.14 – Will County Stormwater Management Ordinance Adopted

The Will County Stormwater Management Ordinance (WCSMO), dated November 15, 2018, as amended from time to time, is hereby adopted and incorporated herein as if fully set forth. The City Building Inspector shall be responsible for the administration of the WCSMO within the jurisdiction of the City and those parts of unincorporated Will or Grundy counties that are within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City or that may be annexed into the City.

#### Section 159.15 – Definition of Floodplain, Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) And Floodway

In addition to the definitions of the floodplain, SFHA and floodway in the WCSMO, as amended from time to time, these areas are generally identified as such on the following maps prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency:

- (A) Panels 405, 408, 409, 410, 415, 416, 417, 420, 430 and 440 of the Flood Insurance Rate Map and the Flood Insurance Study of Will County dated February 15, 2019; and
- (B) Panels 145 and 150 of the Flood Insurance Rate Map and the Flood Insurance Study of Grundy County dated August 2, 2012.

#### **SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY**

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

#### **SECTION 3: REPEALER**

Resolution 2003-19 is hereby repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

#### **SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law, specifically after the ordinance is published in one or more newspapers published in the City of Wilmington, or if no newspaper is published therein, then in one or more newspapers with a general circulation within the City of Wilmington, at least twice within thirty (30) days after this ordinance is passed and approved.
