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ORDINANCE NO. 19-06-18-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROCEDURES FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AT CITY PUBLIC MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington (hereinafter "City") is an Illinois municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Open meetings Act (hereinafter "OMA"), 5 ILCS 120/1 et. seq., requires that any person shall be permitted an opportunity to address public officials under the rules established and recorded by the public body; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the right to Freedom of Speech and has historically encourages public comment at City Council, Committee, and other City meetings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted procedures for public comment and further determines and believes it is in the best interest of the City to amend such procedures for public comment at all City public meetings.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTON 1. RECITALS.

The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the Corporate Authorities.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.

That Section 32.27 of Title III Administration of the Wilmington Code of Ordinances is hereby deleted and replaced by the following:

Section 31.27 Public Meeting Procedures

- (A) Pursuant to Section 120/2.06 of the Open Meeting Act (5 ILCS 120/2.06), any person shall be permitted an opportunity to address public officials under the rules established by the public body. Public comments at all public meetings of the City of Wilmington, including but not limited to Regular and Special City Council meetings and Committee meetings, shall be permitted in accordance with the provisions of this Section.
- (B) An individual desiring to address and/or comment during Public Comments shall submit his/her name to the City Clerk prior to the commencement of the meeting.
- (C) Each individual shall have one opportunity to provide public comments during Public Comments and shall be limited to three (3) minutes per meeting, unless otherwise allowed additional time by the presiding City official at the meeting.
- (D) An individual shall not yield unused time to other speakers.
- (E) If numerous persons wish to comment on a single topic, the City Council may recognize a certain number of individuals who wish to speak in favor of and against, or those who wish to make general comments regarding the topic. The City Council shall not be required to allow every person who wishes to address the issue to do so, but are encouraged to allow as many views as possible to be heard.

- (F) As an alternative to speaking, members of the public may submit written materials to the City Council or committee regarding any matter of public concern.
- (G) Members of the public shall not engage in threats, slander, or disorderly behavior at any City public meeting.
- (H) The presiding officer shall have the right to close each individual's comment when such input violates the provisions of these rules, or is otherwise irrelevant, unduly repetitious or disruptive.

SECTION 3: REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY

This Ordinance and every provision thereof shall be considered severable. In the event that any court of competent jurisdiction may find and declare any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section or part of a phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section of this Ordinance is void or unconstitutional, the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, provisions and sections and parts of phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraph, provisions, and section not ruled void or unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided

ORDINANCE NO. <u>19-06-18-02</u>

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A FIRST AMENDED INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, WESLEY TOWNSHIP, AND WESLEY TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRCT

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, authorizes units of local government, such as municipalities and townships to contract or otherwise associate among themselves in any manner not prohibited by law or by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/3) provides that any powers, privileges or authority exercised or which may be exercised by a unit of local government may be exercised and enjoyed jointly with any other unit of local government where not prohibit by law; and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2006, the City of Wilmington passed its Ordinance No. 06-10-17-02 annexing property of Wesley Township, Will County, Illinois depicted and described in the attached Exhibit 1 into the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, On October 17, 2006, by way of Ordinance No. 06-10-17-02, the City of Wilmington (hereinafter referred to as the "City") and Wesley Township (hereinafter referred to as the Township") entered into an intergovernmental agreement to establish their respective rights and obligations relating to the maintenance of that portion of Ballou Road and the service road to the Wesley Township building, which is sometimes also referred to as S. Rivals Road as depicted in Exhibit 1 and that a copy of that Agreement is attached as Exhibit 2; and

WHEREAS, the Wesley Township Road District (hereinafter referred to as the Road District") is responsible for the maintenance of any and all Township roadways, and is a necessary party to an agreement relating to the maintenance of roadways involving the Township; and

WHEREAS, the City, Township, and Road District (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties") agree to amend the prior agreement to include all necessary parties and to clarify the property that is to be maintained pursuant to the Parties' agreement and that a copy of the First Amended Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement is attached as Exhibit 3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS STATUTORY AND OTHER POWERS AS FOLLOWS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. RECITALS INCORPORATED

The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the corporate authorities.

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION AND EXECUTION

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sign and the City Clerk is hereby directed to attest the FIRST AMENDED INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, WESLEY TOWNSHIP, AND WESLEY TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT (the "Agreement") attached hereto as Exhibit 3, and the City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to record this Ordinance and Agreement with the Will County Recorder's Office.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall

not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: REPEALER

Ordinance No. 06-10-17-02 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed but only when the First Amended Intergovernmental Agreement attached as Exhibit 3 has been approved and signed by all named parties and is in effect.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS (Wesley Township Property)

WEREAS, a Petition to voluntarily annex certain territory signed pursuant to law has been filed with the City of Wilmington, Will County, Illinois; and



INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WILMINGTON AND WESLEY TOWNSHIP (Wesley Township Property)

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this day of October, 2006, by and between the City of Wilmington, Will County, Illinois, (hereinafter referred to as the "City") and Wesley Township, Will County, Illinois, (hereinafter referred to as the "Township"), sometimes collectively referred to as the parties, in the exercise of their intergovernmental cooperative powers under Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution and the Intergovernmental Cooperative Act;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, authorizes units of local government, such as municipalities and townships to contract or otherwise associate among themselves in any manner not prohibited by law or by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/3) provides that any powers, privileges or authority exercised or which may be exercised by a unit of local government may be exercised and enjoyed jointly with any other unit of local government where not prohibit by law; and

WHEREAS, the City recently annexed certain property owned by the Township into the City's corporate limits, which said property includes a portion of Ballou Road and a service road to the Township building and related structures; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to establish their respective rights and obligations relating to the maintenance of the above mentioned roadways and Township property; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Township have authorized, by ordinance or resolution, the execution of this Agreement as an exercise of their respective authority and as an exercise of their intergovernmental cooperation authority under the Constitution of laws of the State of Illinois;



FIRST AMENDED INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, WESLEY TOWNSHIP, AND WESLEY TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT

THIS FIRST AMENDED AGREEMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of June, 2019, by and between the City of Wilmington, Will County, Illinois, (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), Wesley Township, Will County, Illinois (hereinafter referred to as the "Township"), and Wesley Township Road District, Will County, Illinois (hereinafter referred to as the "Road District"), sometimes collectively referred to as the Parties, in the exercise of their intergovernmental cooperative powers under Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution and the Intergovernmental Cooperative Act;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, authorizes units of local government, such as municipalities and townships to contract or otherwise associate among themselves in any manner not prohibited by law or by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/3) provides that any powers, privileges or authority exercised or which may be exercised by a unit of local government may be exercised and enjoyed jointly with any other unit of local government where not prohibit by law; and

WHEREAS, On October 17, 2006, the City annexed certain property owned by the Township and Road District into the City's corporate limits by passage of Ordinance No. 06-10-17-02, which said property includes a portion of Ballou Road and a service road to the Township building, sometimes referred to as S. Rivals Road which annexed property is portrayed and described in the attached Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, On October 17, 2006, the City and Township entered into an intergovernmental agreement to establish their respective rights and obligations relating to the maintenance of a portion of Ballou Road and a service road to the Township building, sometimes referred to as S. Rivals Road; and

WHEREAS, the Road District is responsible for the maintenance of any and all Township roadways, and is a necessary party to an agreement relating to the maintenance of roadways involving the Township;

WHEREAS, the Parties agree to amend the prior agreement to include all necessary parties and to clarify the property that is to be maintained pursuant to the Parties' agreement;

WHEREAS, the City, the Township, and Road District have authorized, by ordinance or resolution, and agree to the execution of this First Amended Agreement as an exercise of their respective authority and as an exercise of their intergovernmental cooperation authority under the Constitution of laws of the State of Illinois;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the following and mutual covenants and promises as hereinafter set forth the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the parties, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF RECITALS

The Recitals to the Preamble hereto and all Exhibits referred to in this
