#### **ORDINANCE NO. 18-12-18-01**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF
A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDED AND
RESTATED ANNEXATION AGREEMENT BY AND AMONG
ADAR RIDGEPORT INDUSTRIAL PARTNERS, LLC, ADAR RPLL, LLC,
RIDGEPORT LOGISTICS CENTER PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION
AND THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, ILLINOIS
(RIDGE PORT LOGISTICS CENTER)

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/11-15.1-1 *et seq.* grant municipalities the right to enter into annexation agreements with the owners of property in unincorporated territory, and to thereafter amend said annexation agreements during the term thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Wilmington, Will County, Illinois (the "City"), that a "First Amendment to the "Amended And Restated Annexation Agreement by and Among Adar Ridgeport Industrial Partners, LLC, Adar RPLL, LLC, Ridgeport Logistics Center Property Owners Association and the City of Wilmington, Illinois (Ridge Port Logistics Center)" ("First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement") be entered into by the City; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 28, 2018, the City published a notice in regard to a public hearing relative to the aforementioned First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement in the *Free Press Advocate* newspaper, a copy of said notice being attached hereto as <u>Exhibit 1</u> and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the City Council in regard to the aforementioned First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement on December 18, 2018; and

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**WHEREAS**, a copy of said First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement is attached hereto as <a href="Exhibit 2">Exhibit 2</a> and is made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the territory which is the subject of said First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement are willing and able to enter into said First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement and fulfill the obligations thereunder; and

**WHEREAS**, the statutory provisions of 65 ILCS 5/11-15.1-1 *et seq.*, as amended, for execution of said First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement have been fully complied with;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wilmington, Will County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit 2, between the City of Wilmington, Adar Ridgeport Industrial Partners, LLC, Adar RPLL, LLC, and the Ridgeport Logistics Center Property Owners Association is hereby approved.

**SECTION 2:** That the Mayor and Deputy City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign the First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto as <a href="Exhibit 2">Exhibit 2</a>.

**SECTION 3:** That, upon the execution of said First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement by all parties thereto, the Deputy City Clerk is hereby directed to record same with the Will County Recorder of Deeds.

**SECTION 4:** That the various provisions of this Ordinance are to be considered severable and if any part or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid by any court of

competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5:** That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with, or which are inconsistent with, this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict or inconsistency.

**SECTION 6:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by a two-thirds (2/3rds) vote of the Corporate Authorities, adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE This AMENDED AND RESTATED ANNEXATION AGREEMENT BY AND AMONG ADAR RIDGEPORT INDUSTRIAL PARTNERS, LLC, ADAR RPLL, LLC, RIDGEPORT LOGISTICS CENTER PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION AND THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, ILLINOIS (RIDGE PORT LOGISTICS CENTER) ("First Amendment") is made and entered into this 18th day of December, 2018, by and among the CITY OF WILMINGTON, an Illinois municipal corporation, Will County, Illinois ("City"), by and through the Mayor and City Council of the City, ADAR RIDGEPORT INDUSTRIAL PARTNERS, LLC, a Delaware limited Liability Company ("Adar"), ADAR RPLL, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, and RIDGEPORT LOGISTICS CENTER PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation. The parties to this First Amendment are collectively referred to herein as the "Parties."

#### WITNESS:

WHEREAS, the Parties are parties to that certain "Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement by and Among Adar Ridgeport Industrial Partners, LLC, Adar RPLL, LLC, Ridgeport Logistics Center Property Owners Association and the City of Wilmington, Illinois (Ridge Port Logistics Center)," which was recorded with the Office of the Recorder of Will County, Illinois on November 3, 2017, as Document Number R2017086922 ("Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement"); and

- **WHEREAS**, the Parties have determined that it is in the best interest of the Parties to amend the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement as set forth herein, to add the real property legally described and depicted in <u>Exhibits A-1</u> and <u>A-2</u>, respectively, attached hereto and made a part hereof ("*Additional Property*"), to the "Subject Property" as defined in the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement; and
- **WHEREAS**, proper applications and petitions have been filed with the City by Adar to amend the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement to add the Additional Property to the "Subject Property" as defined in the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Parties desire to enter into this First Amendment pursuant to the provisions of Division 15.1 of Article 11 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-15.1, in order to regulate the annexation, zoning and development of the Additional Property, in order that the Additional Property be annexed to the City and be developed on the terms and conditions contained in the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement; and
- **WHEREAS**, Section 42 of the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement contemplates that real property abutting the "Subject Property," as defined in the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement, such as the Additional Property, may be annexed into the City and be made subject to the terms of the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement as "Additional Territory," as defined in the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement; and
- **WHEREAS**, a public hearing on this First Amendment was held by the Mayor and City Council of the City ("*Corporate Authorities*") on December 18, 2018; and
- **WHEREAS**, all other required public hearings and notices in connection with the terms and conditions of this First Amendment, have been held and given in accordance with the ordinances of the City and the statutes of the State of Illinois; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the City, after due and careful consideration, have concluded that the annexation and development of the Subject Property, upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, would further the growth of the City and service the best interests of the citizens of the City; and
- **WHEREAS**, by a favorable vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the Corporate Authorities of the City then holding office, an ordinance has been adopted authorizing the execution of this First Amendment.
- **NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants and agreements herein contained, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

#### Section 1. <u>Incorporation of Recitals and Exhibits.</u>

The preceding "Whereas" clauses and all the Exhibits referred to therein are hereby made a part of this First Amendment and incorporated herein as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

#### Section 2. Annexation Subject to Annexation Agreement.

The Additional Property shall be annexed to the City and shall thereafter be deemed part of the "Subject Property," as defined in the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement, and Exhibit A to the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement is hereby amended to include the legal description of the Additional Property in Exhibit A-1 to this First Amendment, and the Additional Property shall be subject, as applicable, to all the terms and conditions of the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement.

#### Section 3. Zoning of Additional Property.

Upon annexation of the Additional Property into the City, the Corporate Authorities of the City shall rezone the Additional Property to the I-5 Large Scale Planned Industrial Zoning District.

#### **Section 4.** General Provisions.

- A. Except as modified by this First Amendment, the provisions of the Amended and Restated Annexation Agreement shall remain in full force and effect
- B. This First Amendment shall bind and insure to the benefit of the heirs, successor and assigns of the Parties.
- C. This First Amendment, when recorded, constitutes a covenant running with the land and is binding on and insures to the benefit of the Parties, all grantees, successors and assigns.
- D. Within thirty (30) days after its execution, this First Amendment shall be recorded, at the sole cost and expense of Adar, in the Office of the Recorder of Will County, Illinois.
- E. If any provision of this First Amendment is found by a court of law to be in violation of any applicable local, State or Federal law, ordinance or regulation, and if a court of competent jurisdiction should declare any provision of this First Amendment to be illegal, void or unenforceable, then it is the intent of the Parties that the remainder of this First Amendment shall be construed as if such illegal, void or unenforceable provision was not contained herein and that the rights and obligations of the Parties hereunder shall continue in full force and effect.
- F. The captions of Sections in this First Amendment are intended only for the convenience of the Parties and are not to be construed as part of this First Amendment or as a l imitation of the scope of the particular Sections to which they refer.
- G. This First Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts and duplicate originals, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.

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





# AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY IN RELATION TO THE RIDGEPORT LOGISTICS CENTER



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



## AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AS SURPLUS CERTAIN EQUIPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO DISPOSE OF SAID EQUIPMENT IN A MANNER IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 provides for the methodology to dispose of certain municipal property which is no longer necessary or useful to a city; and

WHEREAS, the Wilmington Police Department has determined that certain personal property belonging to the City of Wilmington in use by the Police Department is no longer necessary or useful to the Department or City; and

WHEREAS, based on the above, a simple majority of the corporate authorities of the City of Wilmington is of the opinion that the personal property is no longer necessary or useful to the City of Wilmington; and

WHEREAS, said personal property can be sold or transferred for the benefit of the City's General Corporate Fund.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section One</u>: the following items are hereby declared to be surplus property, and no longer of use to the City of Wilmington:

Four (4) International Road Dynamics, Inc. Portable Scales

<u>Section Two</u>: The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to dispose of said equipment in a manner consistent with applicable State laws and in the best interest of the City of Wilmington.

<u>Section Three: Severability:</u> This Ordinance and every provision thereof shall be considered severable. In the event that any court of competent jurisdiction may find and declare any portion invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portions not ruled invalid or unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect.

<u>Section Four: Repealer</u>: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
